The clinics are:

- April 20: Goderich, 10:30 a.m.- 4:30 p.m. - Maitland Recreation Centre (YMCA)
- April 22: Stratford, 10:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. - Rotary Complex

These are age-based clinics only, with no other eligibility requirements. Anyone born in 1966 or earlier can book an appointment.
